


The Fraternal Twins (solution)

This is a typical Fraternal Twins puzzle with one exception – there is an extra letter per section from Shaniya's word clues that gets “cut” before entering into the sari-shaped grid, allowing the remaining letters in each six-space section to correspond with each other. This is clued in several ways:

- Shaniya's clues do not have enumerations given, possibly suggesting that their lengths do not add to the same as Anisha's clues.
- The names Shaniya and Anisha are a demonstration of this, with SHANIYA being an anagram of ANISHA with an extra letter.
- The given picture also depicts Shaniya as being taller, which could suggest that her sari requires more cloth.

Taking the “cut” letters in order, we get ANS TWO FACED. Therefore, the answer is **TWO-FACED**.

Constructor's Notes:

This puzzle was inspired by [Alice's Adventures in Wonderland](#) from the 2022 MIT Mystery Hunt. “Fraternal twins” fit the family theme of round 1 pretty well, so I tried to do an original take on this puzzle type.
