

Organizing (solution)

The puzzles lists the names actors (split into two groups of 14 and 129), and the footnote on using IMDB hints that solvers need to first find the common movies that these actors have starred in. The Venn diagram has 14 overlapping circles suggesting there are 14 movies to be identified. This also matches the number of actors in the first group, and thus the aha is that these actors belong to the overlapping sections, which means that these actors have starred in exactly two of the 14 movies (unlike the others which starred in exactly one). So this first group could be a helpful starting point to identify or confirm the movies, as well as which circles they correspond to. The second group of actors also contain a good number who could be recognized together as cast members of popular movies. Although the second aha is that the 14 movies are all part of movie franchises, so the exact movie within the franchise needs to be identified using specific actors who appeared in addition to the recurring cast members. The given letters for each actor in each movie (in alphabetical order of their names), form a word or phrase that matches the given enumeration in its matching circle. After matching all the movies to circles, the given indices of the overlapping circles can be used to extract a letter from the name of the actor who starred in the two matching overlapping movies. The tables below summarize the movies (clockwise order from top-middle in Venn diagram), actors (the first two in each table in blue are the ones from the first group who straddle two movies, and have an extracted letter using the index in the matching overlapping section), their character/s portrayed (for info), and the words/phrases formed by the given letters for these actors in alphabetical order of their names:

Note the given enumeration for each circle also clues the total number of actors that matches that movie (excluding the two from the first group that match to two movies each).

For the extraction step, the flavortext hints that order is important, and the extracted clue phrase from the first group of actors, in clockwise order of the Venn diagram (starting from top-middle) reads **I NEED TWO ORDERS**. As each of the movies is part of a movie franchise

series, the chronological order of release of each movie in that series is the first order you need, that can be used as an index to extract a letter from its corresponding answer. These extracted letters will still need to be reordered though.

Each of the answers is similarly an element of an ordered series, which is also indirectly related to the movie's title or theme (as a way of confirmation). The order of the answer element within this series is the second order you need, that can be used as the reordering for the extracted letters to give the answer for this puzzle **CUSTOMIZED PACK**. The table below summarizes the extraction and reordering steps:

Constructor's notes:

Since this is a puzzle themed around an organizing task, the idea was for it to involve identifying and sorting elements into sets, and intentionally in relatively large quantities so as to really make it closer to the feel of the theme/task. But an ISIS puzzle of a large scale may require too much online research and grunt work. So I picked a pop culture topic that is widely-known to most solvers, and also used popular movie series that many should be familiar with, and can recognize the names of the main cast. This should allow the majority of the team to have fun by participating in the solving and contributing insights, while without the need for excessive online research. The identification of the movies and ordered sets also became interesting solving steps and variety beyond the ISIS component. The selection of the movies were quite constraining, as I wanted to introduce the Venn diagram aspect of actors who appeared in two different movies (to help in their identification). So these actors and movies had to form a closed loop. I also omitted the use of the most expected MCU series, given the potential ambiguities in which order to use and the different sub-series for the different characters. The choice of the ordered sets was also very constraining, as the single given element needed to be clear enough to clue the intended set. To make this approach more viable, and help in the identification, I decided to pick ordered sets which were indirectly related to the movie title or theme (which would also be more elegant). While these indirect references are tangential in various degrees, I was quite satisfied that they were reasonable and the majority may also give an unexpected fun surprise to solvers when they figure out the connection.
