

HARVESTER



The harvester is a huge mobile factory that traverses the spice fields and does the gathering and processing of melange.

The harvesters move around a spice field represented by the grid on the following page.

Each of them moves in a contiguous path from one adjacent cell to the next (either orthogonally or diagonally), gathering everything along its path, besides spice.

Harvester 2 – Things with teardrop symbol

Harvester 3 – Things with skull symbol

Harvester 4 – Things with tree symbol

Harvester 5 – Things that are ancient relics

Harvester 7 – Things that are critters

Harvester 8 – Things that could have any type of non-mechanical planes symbol

Harvester 9 – Things that could have any type of shield symbol
